3. Higher Education Scholarship applications have deadlines. **Fall deadline is July 15. Spring deadline is December 15.** Applications must be filled out completely and all documents must be turned in to be considered complete.

- ◆ The applicant must be attending an accredited 2 year or 4 year college or university.
- ◆ Must apply for FAFSA
- ◆ A completed application with all documents attached. There is a checklist of documents you need to turn in.
- ◆ An application is considered complete when required documents have been received. **Deadlines: December 15 for Spring Semester. July 15 is for Fall Semester.**
- ◆ Please make sure to follow the checklist attached to the application.


BIA JPT Programs

Direct Employment Assistance:

- * This program is for any Iowa tribe member or other natives enrolled in a federally recognized tribe that reside in Iowa Jurisdiction
- * Iowa jurisdiction location is south of Hwy 51 (6th street) to west of US HWY 18 to Meridian and North of Deep Fork River on the south.
- * This program is designed for individuals that have recently started employment and need assistance for job related needs.
- * Please complete an application and turn in with the documents required on checklist.

Adult Vocational Training:

- * This program is for any Iowa tribe member or other natives enrolled in a federally recognized tribe that reside in Iowa Jurisdiction
- * Iowa jurisdiction location is south of Hwy 51 (6th street) to west of US HWY 18 to Meridian and North of Deep Fork River on the south
- * This program is designed to help individuals who graduated or left high school and need additional vocational training to create better opportunities in the workforce.
